

Camp COVID-19 Safety Precautions

Disease Prevention

- If you are sick, stay home. If you have been exposed to someone with COVID, stay home. A full refund will be issued if you cannot come to camp any day; a partial refund will be issued for any days you have to miss due to COVID/illness.
- Avoid close contact with those who are already sick.
- Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing with a tissue or the crook of your arm.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, or mouth.

Camp Sanitization

- Camp size is limited to 6 campers to allow for social distancing. Whether we are outdoors or inside the cabana, we will follow social distancing guidelines.
- I will use a touchless forehead thermometer to take and record temperatures at the beginning of the day. If the temperature is elevated, students will be given a take-home lesson packet and will be sent home.
- I am fully vaccinated, but will wear a mask if parents ask me to do so.
- Parents and students must follow the local guidelines on whether or not they should wear their own masks or face shields. Campers do not need to wear a mask when we can maintain a distance of 6 feet.
- We will make hand washing a priority and there will be sanitizer stations set up.
- Some of the activities require sharing of items. Items will be sanitized before passed on to the next camper.
- A thorough sanitization of the cabana and camp items will be completed at the end of each day.
- Provided snacks and drinks will be pre-packaged, disposable items. Campers should plan to bring a personal water bottle to fill throughout the day.
